Update on ATD Coaches Campus Visits</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cuyamaca College (<i>April 25</i>)• Grossmont College (<i>April 26</i>)	<p>Comments on campus visits:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• It was great to have the ATD coaches' leadership and evaluation.• The meetings went well with good understanding going forward.• Useful feedback.• Proud to showcase our efforts that we are at the cusp of becoming a great ATD institution.• It was an exciting day with two tandem planning sessions morning and afternoon. <p>Cindy asked if meeting with the coaches changed their perspective:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The coaches had the ability to implement and make everyone think about how the work of ATD engages everyone during change.• The coaches highlighted the topics and issues that everyone needed to hear. <p>Cindy asked how the difference in structure was, as it relates to having the data coach work separately:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• It was both successful and unsuccessful depending on the topic. Engagement was hard and is highly dependent on discussion outcomes.

Cuyamaca Report Out on ATD Plan Implementation	<p>Update from Cuyamaca College:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Part of the implementation is having Human Resources on campus to help roll out the initiatives. • Getting data from one perspective and making it relevant. Defined classes, engagement aspect, and instructional faculty.

Grossmont Report Out on ATD Plan Implementation	<p>Update from Grossmont College:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A proposal was developed prior to the ATD coaches visit. • A new flow chart was created to show the first and last point of contact, and to know what comprehensive outreach is, and what someone can do individually to assist with student success initiatives. • The group has begun working on items for next year. <p>Everyone should take great pride in the work that has been done at both campuses.</p> <p>Regarding staffing for ATD implementation, Tim and the Human Resources team have been working on staff reclassifications, and came to (some staffing) solutions. Tim will review those with Michael Copenhaver and then positions will be posted.</p>
