**New and Relevant Issues**

Colleague

- Last date of attendance for F/NP grades and impact on Veterans and Financial Aid benefits – update from Sue Gonda after discussion with Michael Copenhaver – LDA not required for F/NP; is required for W; faculty currently entering LDA for drops; Sheri to check workflow for student process
- Repeat “families” – phase II to be implemented for Fall 2014; working on “master” list with input from both colleges; will be coded into Colleague the week of July 7th
- Changes to Priority Registration for Fall 2014
  - New Students and Special Populations must be “matriculated” to receive priority
  - Over 90 units now includes Special Populations; except Foster Youth
  - 2 consecutive terms of probation (will fall into open registration)
- Additional changes requested for Spring 2015
  - Athletes (matriculated and eligible to participate)
  - FYE and FA for a full year
- Revisions to repeat policy regarding Academic Renewal

Student Success – working on project plan/timeline for next steps

ERP Procurement – reviewing pricing and next steps

**Ongoing Projects with Change in Status**

Accuplacer – interface is now running hourly; issue with waivers (vs test scores) and ability to advise

Cynosure – need to develop interface to Colleague; for 508 compliance, orientation is complete and advising is scheduled by 5/27; initial Ed Plan reprint should be available on 5/12

DARS – validating enhancements and new coding; target is to have all issues resolved in May

Colleague

- Online Transcript requests – testing “generic” transcript
- New web UI for power users; to all users in June; optional training will be scheduled

Document Imaging – defining document type; checking with departments for requirements; training scheduled in early June

IFAS checks – revisions required based on Payee Verification standards; continue to test each check proof

Windows 7/ Windows XP – large project; efforts continue to move all computers to Windows 7

Wireless – Prop V Project; goal is for 100% coverage and include planning for BYOD; engaging HP for discussion on entire infrastructure (coverage and capacity will be included)

- Hire letters – working on fine tuning how “hours” are calculated; impact on MIS and 320 reporting
- Probation and Dismissal – discussion based on new regulations
