New and Relevant Issues to Be Discussed

 - a. Fall 2015 Priority Registration Process
 - i. DSPS Students that have more than 90 units or have been on Probation two terms will continue to be included if their Program Plan specifies that Priority registration is a needed accommodation – this requires data entry by DSPS or ? – and new programming by IS
 - ii. Students falling into Open Reg will also be assigned a date/time to protect system performance – 13,000 Students Thurs Dec 5-10, 11 is unassigned
 - b. Software Upgrades
 - i. Contract with Ellucian to assist; last update was through April 2013
 - ii. New releases includes improved functionality for pre-requisites and co-requisites
 - iii. Downtime – Spring Break week of Mar 23
 - c. MIS reporting for Summer - completed
 - d. Academic Program / Major – DARS, Fin Aid, WebAdvisor -
 - e. 4 year CIP approval – VPs of Instruction / Instructional Office
