Chancellor reviewed the Repopulation 2021 Planning document and proposed the formation of repopulation teams to plan to return to campus at some level in the fall. Technology needs will be woven in throughout all of the Emergency Response Teams. Teams should be kept smaller to avoid scheduling difficulties. Denise and Manuel agreed to participate. ● Kim D. noted the teams will need to communicate regarding issues that cross-pollenate between teams. ● Teams should be thinking about strategic uses for stimulus funds as repopulation plans are being formulated.
