Hopefully the bulk of the repopulation planning will be completed by the end of March in order to prepare for the fall semester. Meetings will be widely accessible to anyone who wants to attend or observe via Zoom and/or YouTube. Team membership is at the discretion of the team leads. Jeff W. suggested that the Academic Senate Presidents be co-chairs. Denise and Manuel agreed to participate. Kim D. noted the teams will need to communicate regarding issues that cross-pollenate between teams. Teams should be thinking about strategic uses for stimulus funds as repopulation plans are being formulated.

C. Campus Security Task Force— Sahar • GCCCD Campus Safety Open Forums	 Sahar A. shared the GCCCD Campus Safety Open Forums Announcement, which had been previously sent out. More forums will be added if needed. Survey results will be reviewed at the forums. Links with the survey results will be sent out in advance so everyone can review in preparation for forums.
