Issues	Discussion, Action, and Follow-Up
A. IS Quarterly Report	Brian Nath and Henry Eimstad presented a quarterly report on information systems including the recent hardware upgrade, website update, staff retirements, and replacement hires.

	Rearic reported that the Water Conversation Garden volunteers need to be listed on a docket item. She is currently reviewing whether they can be listed with the other volunteers on <i>Item 501 Personnel Actions</i> , or if they must be listed on a separate docket item.
	Rearic stated the audits being presented to the Board are all clean audits with no findings. A presentation by the auditors will be added to the Board agenda.

C. 4/10 Summer Schedule Analysis <i>(Miles)</i>	Rearic distributed the <i>Summer 2010 4/10 Work Schedule</i> <i>Survey Results, Survey Results Summary,</i> and <i>Financial</i> <i>Analysis.</i> After lengthy discussion on the distributed information and the impact on students, council members agreed to recommend a 4/10 work schedule for Summer 2011 with details of starting and ending dates to follow.
	Action: The employee survey responses will be disaggregated by classification (managers, classified, faculty). Patterns among responses might show areas and ways to better address needs.
