# Summer 2010 4/10 Work Schedule <br> Survey Results <br> Summary 

1. Survey participants:

333 employees participated in this survey. $65 \%$ were classified employees, $23 \%$ faculty, and $12 \%$ supervisors, managers or administrators
2. Students and vendors/customers needs were adequately served during the Summer 4/10 work schedule:
$86 \%$ of respondents were either in agreement or neutral, $14 \%$ disagreed.
3. Students and vendors/customers were adequately notified regarding the Summer 4/10 work schedule:
$90 \%$ of respondents were either in agreement or neutral, $10 \%$ disagreed.
4. I used vacation/comp time to reduce my ten-hour schedule:
$64 \%$ of respondents used no vacation or comp time, $36 \%$ used some amount.
5. Overall, I was satisfied with the Summer $4 / 10$ work schedule: $79 \%$ of respondents were either in agreement or neutral, $21 \%$ disagreed.
6. I would like to have a $4 / 10$ schedule for Summer 2011:

81\% of respondents said "Yes" or "Maybe," while19\% said "No."
7. Our office was able to meet its regular operational demands:

85\% of respondents were either in agreement or neutral, 15\% disagreed.
8. Our department was able to cover the 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. commitment for operations:
$97 \%$ of respondents were either in agreement or neutral, $3 \%$ disagreed.
9. I observed a change in the quality of work in my department resulting from employees working extended hours:

69\% of respondents observed no change or increased quality, while $31 \%$ observed decreased quality.
