Rationale for Proposed Procedure or Revision (use “track changes”):

Pursuant to CCLC’s counsel, this policy and procedure is *legally required* to comply with recent changes in federal law. CCLC provided a template. No GCCCD information or local practice has been inserted.

The policy also incorporates language from current GCCCD policy BP 3845 Dogs and Other Pets on District Property, which would then be removed from the District’s policy list. BP 3845 was not from a CCLC template nor legally required.

Explanation of impacts:

- Service animals will be allowed in all areas of the District’s facilities where members of the public are allowed to go
- This policy and procedure are also applicable to an individual who is training a service animal

FYI:

- A service animal for purposes of this policy and procedure means any dog or miniature horse that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability
- May require coordination with DSPPS
- It could require additional space accommodations in a classroom or lab facility
