In accordance with board policy, the Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District implements an educational philosophy by providing a variety of programs to broaden student opportunity. This includes an Occupational/Vocational Technical Program to provide technical skills and knowledge for beginning employment, retraining, and advancement. The Chancellor, in keeping with Board Policy 2510, shall establish procedures related to the Occupational/ Vocational Technical Programs which address:

- Establishment of an appointment process for related advisory committees; and
- Provisions for documenting the competence of students completing vocational and occupational programs.
