BP 4231 Grade Challenges

Reference: ***Education Code Sections 76224 and 76232; and
Title 5 Section 55025***

Adoption Date:

The Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District (District) Chancellor shall ensure that administrative procedures are written regarding grade challenges by District students. The procedures shall include but not be limited to the following components:

1. When grades are given for any course of instruction taught in a community college district, the grade given to each student shall be the grade determined by the instructor of the course; and the determination of the student's grade by the instructor, in the absence of mistake, fraud, bad faith, or incompetency, shall be final.
2. Students may challenge an assigned grade within the timelines set forth in the administrative procedures.
