BP 4260 Pre-Requisites and Co-Requisites

It shall be the policy of the <u>Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District (District)</u>
Board that the Academic Senates, upon the recommendation of the Curriculum
Committees and with the assistance of <u>the-appropriate</u> colleges' <u>respective matriculation</u>
committees, shall utilize the State Model District Policy to establish and enforce course
and skill pre-requisites, co-requisites, as well as advisories for recommended
preparation in accordance with Title 5.

The procedures shall include a way in which a pre-requisite or co-requisite may be challenged by a student on grounds permitted by law. Pre-requisites, co-requisites, and advisories shall be identified in District publications available to students.
