Grade forgiveness as defined by the Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District (District) is the intentional omission of courses in which "D" or "F" grades are earned when computing grade point average (GPA) for the granting of degrees.

The forgiveness policy is used only when a student has less than a 2.0 GPA and is automatically applied at the time of graduation, or upon completion of the student's last semester. This policy does not affect GPAs used by other colleges or universities.
