Grade forgiveness <u>is as</u> defined <u>by the Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College</u> <u>District (District) as is</u> the intentional omission of courses in which "D" or "F" grades are earned when computing grade point average (GPA) for the granting of degrees.\_ Under the forgiveness policy, degree candidates must meet all the requirements stated in the <u>Grossmont eCollege and Cuyamaca College</u> catalogs with the following exception:

Any course in which a "D" or "F" grade is earned may be forgiven without repeating if that particular course is not being used to meet degree requirements at a college within the District, and when the grade point average GPA prior to forgiveness is below 2.0, and the grade point average GPA after grade forgiveness is 2.0 or better.
