The <u>Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District (District)</u> Chancellor is delegated to declare as surplus such personal property of the District as is no longer useful for District purposes, and shall establish procedures to dispose of such property in accordance with applicable law._ All sales of surplus personal property shall be reported to the <u>Governing</u> Board on a periodic basis.
