The Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District (District) Chancellor shall ensure that administrative procedures are written regarding International Students enrolling at Grossmont College or Cuyamaca College. The Chancellor shall ensure that the procedures for International Students shall be published in the Grossmont College and Cuyamaca College catalogs and posted on the District website.

International Student applicants whose native language is not English shall demonstrate appropriate college level English skills prior to enrollment in the District's colleges. [Moved to AP]
