Spring Registration Dates (Cooke)		Sunny brought forward a recommendation to move the Spring registration date from Monday, Nov. 19, to Monday, Nov. 26, based on two factors: the Nov. 19 date is earlier than usual (the Monday of Thanksgiving week), and this will give the District more time for necessary action following the vote on <i>Proposition 30</i> . Council members were in favor of the recommendation and asked that the information be sent to DCEC for consideration.
		Actions: Valeri will send the recommendation to DCEC for consideration. If no objections are received within a week of the request, the recommendation is approved to move forward.
