Summary of Findings:

- Effectiveness: (n = 11) 72% of respondents found the council to be generally effective.
- **Charge and Membership**: (n = 8) 5 found it appropriate; one found the council only deals with policies/procedures; one did not have enough knowledge to comment; and one feels it is a one-way dialog.
- Committee Meetings: (n = 8) 5 felt the length of meetings was appropriate; one felt most information could be reviewed in written form instead of meeting; one felt the meeting should be 2-hours with notes and agendas distributed earlier; one asked for a break between DEC and DSP&BC; one requested better identification of next steps and follow-up reporting when appropriate.
- **Committee Participation**: (n = 8) 7 said participation is encouraged and valued; one said there is minimal participation the meeting is a presentation.
- Respect of Stakeholders: (n = 8) there was general consensus that stakeholders are respected.

Recommended Improvements:

- Vocalize next steps and share follow-up response at next meeting
- More communication by way of an annual report on DEC representatives, activities and accomplishments and Governance Structure Handbook information
- On subsequent surveys add a hyperlink to the council/committee charge
- Break added between DEC and DSP&BC
