

BP 4260 Prerequisites and Co-requisites

It shall be the policy of the Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District (District) Board that the Academic Senates, upon the recommendation of the Curriculum Committees and with the assistance of appropriate college committees, shall ~~utilize the State Model District Policy to~~ establish and enforce course and skill prerequisites, co-requisites, as well as advisories for recommended preparation in accordance with Title 5.

The procedures shall include a way in which a prerequisite or co-requisite may be challenged by a student on grounds permitted by law. Prerequisites, co-requisites, and advisories shall be identified in District publications available to students.
