Item 202 Resolution 14-010 Grossmont-Cuyamaca College District in support of the California Community Colleges Baccalaureate—it was agreed that although the senate bill language states "baccalaureate degree", the word "degree" would be deleted from the docket and only have "baccalaureate".

Item 502 Implementation of Salary Equity Taskforce Recommendations for 2013/2014 Salary

Schedules—after discussion whether this item should move forward or not, the following was agreed by DEC:

This item will move forward to go to the Governing Board on March 18. However, the language of the docket item will be revised to read, "subject to agreement with each individual unit". Also revising wording to clarify that the implementation is the percent.

This new language will go to DEC and SET for review before posting on Friday.

Discussion items	Action/Follow-Up
	Following the Governing Board meeting on Tuesday, March 18 and with Board approval, the District will move forward with SET adjustments for each unit that has concluded negotiations. Also, following Board approval, new job advertisements will be posted with new salary amount immediately thereafter.
	All salary adjustment effective dates need to be the same – the effective date will still have to be determined.
	Next Steps : As other dollars are available, the SET group will re-convene to talk about the amount and processes moving forward.
	Item 652 Part-Time and Extra-Pay Assignments January 27, 2014, through May 31, 2014—It was noted that there were mistakes on the Cuyamaca College Part-Time Assignment, the amounts are too high. The tracking methods are different, and there are some amounts that need to be corrected.
	Next Steps: Marsha to work with colleges to make corrections. Adjustments to be made before March 18 Board meeting.
