AP 5140 Students with Disabilities

The Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District (District) maintains a plan for the provision of programs and services to students with disabilities designed to assure that they have equality of access to District classes and programs.

The Chancellor shall ensure that the plan and procedures for the District's program, known as Disabled Students Programs and Services (DSPS) will be published in the college catalogs and on the District website, and will address, but not be limited to the following elements:

- Academic accommodations
- Advisory committee
- Eligibility criteria and verification for students with disabilities
- Long-range goals and short term objectives for the program
- Procedure for timely response to accommodation requests involving academic adjustments which, at a minimum, provides for an individualized review of each such request, and permits interim decisions on such requests pending final resolution by the appropriate administrator or designee
- Provisions for course substitution and waivers
- Staffing
- Student educational contract or plan that is developed by a designated person in consultation with the student
- Student rights and responsibilities
- Support services and instruction that is provided
- Technology accessibility
- Verification of disability
