A. Tuesday, December 13, 2022, Governing Board Regular Meeting Draft Docket	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Chancellor, Sahar A., Eric K., and Aimee G. reviewed the Tuesday, December 13, 2022, Governing Board Regular Meeting Draft Docket. There were no comments or questions from the group.
B. Campus Safety Update (Aimee G.)	<p>Aimee G. reported as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> There was a Q&A session today regarding the cameras on campus with the Academic Senates. All labor groups have weighed in on the cameras, but CSEA still needs to sign off. Campus Safety is providing weekly reports to HR, which help facilitate resolving safety issues that arise. <p>Sahar A. reported as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The external lighting project assessment has been completed. Sahar will consult with Ken Emmons and provide a further report at the January DEC meeting.

D. Governance Handbook – Minor Updates (Eric K.) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Revised Governance Handbook • The attached draft includes minor, non-substantive updates to the handbook that were made as part of an annual review. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minor changes are being made to the Governance Handbook pending a comprehensive assessment of districtwide governance through the upcoming IEPI in the spring. • It was suggested that the word “staff” should be replaced with “classified professionals” throughout the Governance Handbook. • It was suggested that gender references throughout the Governance Handbook be made neutral.
E. Institutional Effectiveness Partnership Initiative (IEPI) – Partnership Resource Team (PRT) Visit in Spring 2023 (Eric K.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One of the IEPI goals is to evaluate districtwide governance processes. • One example is the separation of operations and policy functions, which was noted in the external review of IT. • There will be three separate one-day PRT visits. The first will be in February or March; the second will be in April; and the third will be in the fall. • The PRT requested that the meetings be in-person. • There will be broad constituency representation from the District. • There will be one open forum held. Anyone is welcome to provide input at that forum.
