1. Prop R Semi-Annual Report (Gafcon)

J. Davies, Gafcon Senior Program Manager, presented the *Prop R* Program and Project Semi-Annual Progress Report of construction activity for the period July 1 through December 31, 2010. The report included a review of projects during the report period, the status of current projects, and a look forward at upcoming projects. The report will be presented to the Governing Board at the January 18, 2011, Board meeting.

2. Follow-Ups from December 8, 2010, Meeting

- <u>Full-Time Faculty Obligation (FON)</u> In follow-up to the FON overview presented at the
 December meeting, S. Rearic provided additional information concerning the calculation
 of the FON, and electronically reviewed a FON summary and calculation and analysis by
 site
- Analysis of Cost Savings Summer 2009 to Summer 2010 Rearic electronically reviewed cost savings for Summer 2010, as compared to Summer 2009.
- <u>Summer 2011 4/10 Schedule</u> Rearic discussed the recent recommendation by the Districtwide Executive Council (DEC) that the District will follow a 4/10 work schedule for Summer 2011. An announcement will be sent this week to all faculty and staff informing them of the Summer 2011 4/10 schedule.
- <u>Staffing Plans-Intranet</u> Rearic informed members that the status of approved recruitments that are available on the intranet would be updated after the January 18 Board meeting. A column indicating the updated action will be added to the form, and the positions will be sorted alphabetically by site.

3 Nonresident Tuition

Rearic discussed the calculation of the proposed 2011/12 Nonresident Tuition Fee. She reviewed rates set by other districts, and a history of Nonresident Fee rates for GCCCD. During the review, there was discussion concerning whether the District should charge an application fee and/or capital outlay fee, which the District has not charged in the past. In conclusion, it was agreed that the matter of charging, or not charging an application and/or capital outlay fee would be forwarded to Chancellor's Cabinet for further consideration.

4. Budget Updates

Rearic reported that she would be attending the State Chancellor's Office budget workshop on January 14, where updated information concerning the 2010/11 and 2011/12 budgets will be presented.

Abushaban reported that preliminary information received from the State continues to indicate deep cuts in 2011/12. Cuts to the community college system are expected to be at least \$400 million, which would be approximately \$6.2 million for the District.
