Implementation Talking Points

- The District is interested in contracting with Cenergistic to do an analysis of energy use and systems, and then coordinate our energy management efforts, including tracking and communication.
- This is the next step in the District's Facilities Master Plan commitment to sustainability.
- The contract includes an on-site energy specialist assigned to our District:
 - Provided and trained by Cenergistic
 - On-site at least weekly at each college
 - Provide office space and administrative support in the District Services Facilities Office
- Staff roles:
 - District lead – Randy Clark
 - Administrative – Natalie Yturralde
 - Site coordination with Randy Clark – Ken Emmons (GC) and Bruce Farnham (CC)
- Reporting – In addition to ongoing detailed analysis, there will be special summary reports as follows:
 - Periodic reports to DSP&BC
 - Semi-annual progress reports to the Governing Board
- Initial start-up includes four months, with no cost to District
- This five-year contract is funded by guaranteed utility savings
