Tate Hurvitz—his group is looking at unit update work and aligning with the strategic plan, and consolidating. They are moving forward with a few key student engagement activities for both in-class and out-of-class work.

#### 2. Workday Update

#### Chris Tarman reported:

- The Workday front webpage was projected. The left side of the home page has a link called "Workday", once clicked, there is a link called "Updates!" All emails that have been sent out regarding Workday will be in this area.
- Sara Downs is the contact for training on Workday reports.
- Lorenze Legaspi and Sahar Abushaban are the contacts for routing issues. They both sit on the Executive Committee.
- Timesheet entree:
  - Timeline training and implementation is not set yet, Chris will notify everyone when Workday will be ready for timesheet entry.
- Workday training will take time and should be done on its own, flex week may not be the best time.

#### There were two questions:

- When will there be offsite access to Workday?
  - Access to Workday offsite should be available in the fall semester (the goal is September).
- When will department chairs be able to see budgets?
  - ✓ Access to budgets should be available in the next couple of weeks.

On the second page, the out of state tuition and rents are less than \$600k. This is the same total revenues as in the past, so this will be a challenge year for all three sites.
