2022-2023 COVID-19 Emergency Conditions Allowance

Emergency Conditions Background:

- In the event of an emergency, including pandemics, Title 5 provides the State Chancellor authority to hold a district's FTES stable at a level reported prior to the occurrence of the emergency.
- The State Chancellor's office used the 2019-20 FTES reported on Period 1 (P1) Apportionment Attendance Report (CCFS-320) for fiscal year 2019-20, 2020-21, and 2021-22.
- The State Chancellor's office is providing a final extension of this protection for fiscal year 2022-23.

2022-23 Emergency Conditions Requirements:

- Submit an application to the Chancellor's Office no later than September 1, 2022
 - Application submitted 8/23/2022
- Submit a Board approved Emergency Conditions Recovery Plan
 - Board approved Plan 8/9/2022
 - Submitted to the Chancellor's Office 8/23/2022
- Present to the Governing Board an update to the Recovery Plan by February 28, 2023
- Become a member of the CVC-OEI Consortium and sign a Master Consortium Agreement
 - Agreement signed and submitted to the Chancellor's Office 8/24/2022
- Incentivize and prioritize participation in professional development to enhance quality online teaching and learning
- Adopt a Board policy to align reserve balances with recommendations included in the Government Finance Officers Association Budgeting Best Practices by February 28, 2023
 - Updated the Districtwide Goals & Strategic Priorities for 2022-2023 to include:
 - Systematically increase Board reserve toward a goal of two month's operating costs
 - A plan will be presented to DSP&BC in November, 2022

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2022-23 Emergency Conditions Requirements continues:

- Implement the steps to become a Home College and has implemented or committed by the beginning of Spring 2023 to:
 1. Enabling Course Finder API
 2. Completing the steps needed to become Teaching College ready
 3. Joining a scheduled implementation cohort to become a Teaching College

- Submit all MIS data on-time

- Submit audit reports by December 31, 2022

The Chancellor's Office will notify districts of application approval status on October 15, 2022
