* Note:

In January 2024, the State Chancellor's Office distributed a 2007 legal opinion indicating that a district cannot use the calculated rate of a contiguous district if the rate is below the Statewide average cost or the district's average cost. This is a significant departure from past practice that will result in a \$60 increase per unit for nonresident tuition in 2024-2025 (from \$332 to \$399).

After several conversations with the State Chancellor's Office and challenging the legal opinion, they have revised their position and allow districts to use a contiguous district's lower non-resident tuition fee in alignment with the gradual, moderate, and predictable fee increase parameters identified in education code section 76110.
