Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District Nonresident Tuition and Capital Outlay Fees Overview

Education Code section 76140 requires each district governing board to establish the nonresident tuition fee for the following fiscal year by March 1st

Nonresident Tuition Fee Options

The district has seven options for the nonresident tuition:

- Option 1 District Average Cost (district calculation based on PY cost)
- Option 2 District Average cost with 10% or more noncredit FTES (not applicable to our district)
- Option 3 Statewide Average Cost (provided by CCCCO)
- Option 4 Highest Statewide Average Cost (provide by CCCCO)
- Option 5 Contiguous District (an amount not to exceed the fee stablished by the GB of any contiguous district)
- Option 6 An amount Between Statewide Average Cost & District Average cost
 - o Fees adopted must be greater than statewide average cost and less than the district average cost
- Option 7 Comparable States Average (provided by CCCCO)

Nonresident Capital Outlay Fee

The District may charge a capital outlay fee to nonresident students, the lessor of:

- (1) District capital outlay expenditures in the preceding fiscal year divided by total FTES
- (2) Fifty percent of the nonresident tuition fee adopted by the district

Note: Currently no districts in the region charge this fee

Processina Fee for Students from Foreian Countries

The district may charge international applicants a processing fee not to exceed the lesser of:

- (1) The actual cost of processing an application
- (2) \$100

This fee may be deducted from the tuition fee at the time of enrollment
