In fall, Grossmont will work on their ACPs, then in spring, both colleges will compare and reconcile the common ACPs.

Assessments/Needs - Continue with self-service transition away from WebAdvisor (it will not be supported by Ellucian in 2021) as one of the top priorities Student planning – close to being done, barrier with curriculum tracks that require technical discussion - Degree audit (Colleague sees student planning and degree audit together as one) - It was mentioned that when making a change, please consider the impact on transition and resources available
