A. Welcome	Chris Tarman welcomed the team and Larry introduced himself as a new member to the council.
B. Alliance Summit debrief	Cynthia shared that the 6th annual summit held at Cuyamaca was well attended by GCCCD, GUHSD, and MEUSD. The summit was focused on 3 out of 4 alliance goals: 1. Career readiness 2. College awareness and readiness 3. Dual enrollment 4. Student support services The summit engaged all of our districts with guiding questions and responses shared on a Padlet. We received positive feedback. We also announced Chancellor 'Cindy Miles Legacy Scholarship Award'.
C. Workforce Training Coordinating Committee	Workforce Training Coordinating Council (WTCC) is an advisory committee to this council, reconvening this committee on February 6, 2020.
D. Curriculum	The following items were discussed by Cindy and Jeff: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Both colleges will be working on aligning our GE package, meeting first thing in spring and starting with the articulation officers</li> <li>Cuyamaca received approval of their curriculum packet at the November governing board meeting.</li> <li>We must have a cultural diversity graduation requirement by 2021-22.</li> <li>Grossmont is going to copy the basic framework and hope for approval</li> </ul>
E. Guided Pathways	Al Solano will be facilitating our next Joint Guided Pathways meeting on Friday, January 24th.  Pat mentioned that we will need to have common academic career pathways (ACPs). Cuyamaca passed their ACPs last year and is now in the college catalog. It was shared with Grossmont. In fall, Grossmont will work on their ACPs, then in spring, both colleges will compare and reconcile the common ACPs.

Strong Workforce</p>	<p>The following items were shared by Larry and Javier:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Strong Workforce Faculty Institute RFAs were due last Friday, Nov 22<sup>nd</sup> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Faculty will work collaboratively with researchers to complete the investigative research project on retention, persistence, and success outcomes with an equity lenses</li> <li>- Includes coaches to assist in the project</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Pathways navigation Project is moving to year 2 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Year 1 was focused on determining where everyone was at</li> <li>- Year 2 focused more from exploration to movements (intake process, student orientation, career exploration, etc.)</li> <li>- We are currently reviewing tools: Comevo, CCC mypath</li> </ul> </li> <li>• K-12 Workforce grant application is due in December <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- High school decides which community college they want to partner with</li> <li>- This is a high school driven grant model</li> </ul> </li> <li>• We had a Counselor's conference, held on Nov 13 hosted by Foundation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Attendance increased due to strong workforce</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

Operational Assessments/Needs</p>	<p>The following items were discussed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At the Technology Coordinating Council (TCC), Chris mentioned that the council made an effort on IT prioritization. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Continue with self-service transition away from WebAdvisor (it will not be supported by Ellucian in 2021) as one of the top priorities</li> <li>- Student planning – close to being done, barrier with curriculum tracks that require technical discussion</li> <li>- Degree audit (Colleague sees student planning and degree audit together as one)</li> <li>- It was mentioned that when making a change, please consider the impact on transition and resources available</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
