The oldest private university in the country, Anglo-American University (AAU), Prague, Czech Republic, cultivates a global learning environment, promoting analytical, creative and practical thinking in the pursuit of academic excellence. AAU is the first independent Europe institution to receive the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) accreditation recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.

AAU places emphasis on small, interactive classes with a focus on critical and creative thinking, effective communication, and flexibility. AAU offers 14 undergraduate and graduate programs, with courses provided in English. The quality of teaching is guaranteed by a personalized approach with low 8:1 student to faculty ratio. With students from over 70 countries, campus demographics include American, Chinese, Czech, French, Italian, Kazakh, Russian, Slovak, Spanish, and other international students.

AAU cooperates with companies and organizations to enrich the learning experience, interact with the community around us, and prepare achievers to make a positive difference in their careers. Internships are typically included as a part of the curriculum.
