As many of you may know, in yesterday's 2020 primary election, GCCCD Governing Board <u>Trustee Areas 3</u> and <u>4</u> were on the ballot with the following candidates:

Trustee Area 3

Julie Schorr—Grossmont High School teacher Bartosz "Bartek" Murawski—entrepreneur

Trustee Area 4

Elena Adams—GCCCD Governing Board incumbent Jordan Gascon—Precinct Operations Director

Pursuant to GCCCD <u>BP 2100 Board Member Elections</u>, our trustees are elected in even-numbered years by trustee-area elections in the primary and general elections. The two individuals receiving the most votes in the primary go on to the general election in November. The term of office for each trustee is four years following the general election.

With 100% of the precincts reporting for the primary election, the vote count is as follows:
