More than 1.1 million people in San Diego County have already cast their ballots. If you have not voted yet, below are some tips on the voting process.

How to cast your ballot:

- Text VOTE to GOVOTE (468-683) to find your polling place or click on the <u>Registrar of Voters link</u> to find your assigned polling place.
- Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Bring your face mask and plan to maintain social distance.
- If you have a mail-in ballot, drop boxes are available at all polling places, including Cuyamaca College and Grossmont College.
- Did you forget to register to vote? It is not too late. <u>Conditional Voter Registration</u> allows prospective voters to register conditionally and cast a provisional ballot on Election Day at the Registrar of Voters Office or your assigned polling place.

I hope you will exercise your right to participate in our democracy and do your part to help shape the future of our country, our state and our region.
