Below are some resources to help.

To find your polling place or ballot drop-off location, you can text "VOTE" to GOVOTE (468-683) or visit the [County of San Diego Registrar of Voters website](#). Grossmont College's Griffin Gate is serving as an early polling site, meaning you can vote today up until 5 p.m., or tomorrow from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Qualified voters may register to vote on the day of the election, if necessary, through [Conditional Voter Registration](#).

You can also visit the [California Secretary of State website](#) for up-to-date voter information, including the [California Official Voter Information Guide](#), or request an [eVoter Information Pamphlet](#) from the County of San Diego Registrar of Voters.

Remember, the decisions made in this election will shape the future for all of us.
