As many of you know, **Aimee Gallagher**, Vice Chancellor, Human Resources, will be leaving the District to serve as the Associate Vice Chancellor of Human Resources at the San Diego Community College District. Aimee's last day is Thursday, July 20, 2023. Aimee has admirably served as the Vice Chancellor of Human Resources for the past two years bringing a wealth of experience and a fresh perspective. Most notably she helped lead the District to carefully transition back to campus following the pandemic, navigating many difficult legal and safety challenges. She will be missed.

To ensure continuity of services and support in Human Resources during this critically important transition, a long-standing retired Human Resources professional, **Linda Beam**, will serve as the Interim Vice Chancellor, Human Resources for the next five months.
