➤ Grossmont College

Parking lot repairs will be taking place during the winter break and will include the following:

- Repair potholes in lots 1, 2, 3, 4, and 4A
- Repair potholes on perimeter road adjacent to LDS Church
- Stenciling of ADA spaces around campus
- Clean parking structure and parking lots

Additional repairs at Grossmont college will take place in January and will include the striping of parking lots 2, 3, 4, and a portion of 4A.

➤ Cuyamaca College

- Repairs will include some sealing and paving along the perimeter road.
- Striping of student and staff parking lots and improved signage to assist with evening classes at the Child Development Center.

Campus & Parking Services (CAPS)

Under the direction of CAPS Director Nicole Conklin, the following tasks have been completed over the past few weeks:

- Implemented emergency call box assessment and testing to be done every six months on both campuses.
- Donated old police items to the GCCCD Sheriff's office, which freed up storage space and avoided high disposal fees.
