#### **Budget Update**

2012/2013 The recalculation of last year was received. The anticipated 2% forecasted deficit

has been reduced to ¼ of 1% which brings a one-time prior year adjustment to the

District of approximately \$1.4 million.

2013/2014 The P-1 is anticipated soon.

2014/2015 The Tentative Budget and Allocation Formula will be based on the Governor's

January proposal.


#### Finance/HR/Payroll Demonstrations
