### **Budget Update**

The District has received several adjustments to current funds from the State:

2012/2013	\$	149,21
2013/2014		815,48
2014/2015	1	,283,76

 Deficit adjustment
Deficit adjustment and restoration cut
Restoration increase, COLA adjustment, one-time mandated reimbursement, and block grant adjustment

These funds are being run through the Income Allocation Formula. A related budget increase will be included in Item 302 at the next Governing Board meeting. Additionally, after more discussion at DSP&BC, the District has proposed adjusting the deficit factor from 2% to 1%, which would flow an additional \$964,000 through the Formula.

Combined, all these adjustments increase the current year budget by \$3.2 million.



# **Copier Standardization**

A mandatory pre-bid meeting was held on March 10 in connection with District Bid 15.010 for the purchase or lease of copier equipment. Ten potential copier bidders attended the meeting. The bids are due to the District on April 13, 2015, and will then be reviewed by the Consultant and the Copier Standardization Committee.

The District-Diversity Equity & Inclusion Committee (DS-DEI) theme for 2015 is **inclusion**.


DS-DEI hosted the first quarterly New Employees
