Report to the Governing Board April 21, 2015

Budget Update

The district has begun the development of the tentative budget. We are tacking two issues pending state allocation - Growth (Statewide 2%; which was \$109.9M in the January proposal) and \$125M for an increase in base funding for increased operating expenses including employee pensions. Increased costs anticipated at this point are related to FTES Growth and Employee Costs such as step/column/longevity increases and retirement (STRS/PERS) rate increases. The Tentative Budget formula allocation will go to the sites in Mid-May to do their detailed postings. The overall presentation to the Governing Board is scheduled for June 9th.



Purchasing & Contracts Meet & Greet

The District Purchasing & Contracts Office held a *Meet & Greet* event on March 19 at the Cuyamaca College Student Center to inform staff about Purchasing & Contracts functions and processes. A <u>PowerPoint presentation</u> was included, and staff were invited to ask questions. The event was well received with 21 staff members attending. Another *Meet & Greet* event is planned for Fall at Grossmont College.
