# Report to the Governing Board March 20, 2012

### **State Budget Update**

#### 2011-2012

- Trigger 2 \$102m reduction to Community College system and fee increase to balance the system
  - o GCCCD's cut is \$6.3m
  - o This base reduction was reflected in our Adoption Budget
- 2<sup>nd</sup> layer of cuts \$179m mid-year reduction to Community College system
  - Due to a mid-year shortfall in student fee and property tax revenues
  - o GCCCD's portion is \$2.8m
    - The Adoption Budget anticipated and was able to absorb this cut
    - If not used for the current year, the GCCCD set aside would have helped next year. The Adoption Budget, which included board approved 4% holding, kept us from midyear line item budget reductions across the district.

#### 2012-2013

- Initial state deficit estimated \$9.2b. Governor's budget is built on potential tax increases to be considered in November.
  - Last week the Governor reached agreement to unite his tax proposal and the Millionaire's
     Tax proposal to improve the odds of voter approval.
- IF tax passes no additional cuts are estimated for community colleges
- IF tax increases do not pass \$264m cut to community Colleges
  - GCCCD's portion is \$4.2m (5.56% Workload Reduction/Cut to FTES)
