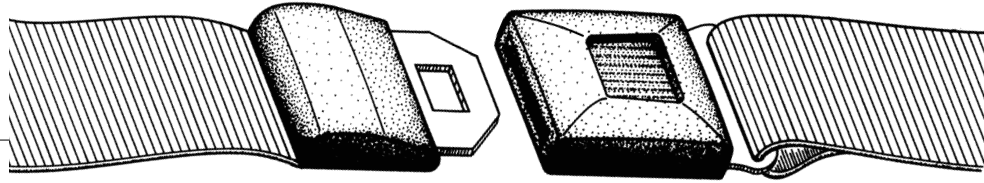


Safety Belts Can Save Your Life
