Charge

In order to advance our institutional commitment to providing learning and working environments that ensure and promote diversity, equity, and inclusion, the Search and Hire Taskforce will review and make recommendations to the search and hire processes. Search and Hire begins at the time a position is approved to be filled and ends at the time of new hire paperwork being completed. With a foundation of equity mindedness and organizational efficiency, the taskforce will conduct both a short term and long term assessment making recommendations to the current processes as well as longer term recommendations associated with the anticipated transition to the Workday Recruiter system.

The recommendations of this taskforce will be submitted to the Chancellor's Cabinet for consideration. Monthly progress reports will be given to Chancellor's Cabinet with a goal of completing the short-term assessment by March 31 and long-term assessment by July 31, 2018.
