Q & A

- Q1: How are counseling services conducted are they in-person? Via telephone? Video conferencing calls?
 - ▶ A: It depends on the provider and the services they are offering.
- Q2: How long are the sessions?
 - A: Sessions are typically one hour.
- Q3: Will this affect my job? Can I get fired for using my EAP?
 - ▶ A: No, these services are completely confidential.
- Q4: Do I need permission from my employer to use EAP services?
 - A: No, the EAP program is part of our benefits.
- Q5: My child is going to college in another state, can she/he still use my EAP benefit?
 - ▶ A: Yes, as long as your dependent is actively covered on your VEBA medical plan.
- Q6: Does EAP cover medication management if prescribed?
 - A: Medication prescribed by an EAP provider will fall under the pharmacy benefits of your medical plan.
- Q7: Can retired employees use EAP?
 - A: Yes, if they are actively covered on the district's VEBA medical insurance.
