New and Relevant Issues to Be Discussed

1. Cuyamaca ITC Report

3. Course Descriptions in WebAdvisor – Brian Nath reported that a blurb description will be used, it will not match the catalog 100%. The Academic Senate Presidents at each college are working with a part-time English instructor on the description of the blurbs together. Brian also stated that the descriptions we have will hopefully be in by next week.
4. Workday – Brian Nath reported that the go live date will be early January. Timesheets in Workday will come later. A training plan is being put together and will be announced soon.
5. Security – Brian Nath reported this is a priority at the highest level. Training needs to be done, and action items will be shared soon. They are working on the ability for people to change their passwords off site, and to also enforce more complex passwords. There will be a discussion about this at Extended Cabinet on Monday.
6. HelpDesk – ICS and IS piloting – Kerry Kilber Rebman reported that Sherri Braaksma is training her staff on this, and would like to go live with it in January. Sang Bai reported that his is comfortable with it. Brian Nath stated it could be a great way to track Workday issues. Brian also said he'd like to roll it out to the phone operators.

2. Infrastructure – Brian Nath reported that some of the new wireless equipment for the pilot configuration in District Services came in. In addition, upgrades of switches needs to be done at both colleges first. He stated we are slowly moving to have a better wifi network.
