Community College District	Classroom Locks
Grossmont-Cuyamaca CCD (2015)	Lever handle on inside and outside – Outside trim can be locked from inside the classroom (Key or Thumb latch) <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Single hand operation• Opened from the outside with a key Von Duprin – Panic Device (over 50 occupancy) New doors – access control card compatible
Palomar CCD (date unknown)	Lever handle on inside and outside – not lockable from inside <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Single hand operation• Shall be able to be opened from the outside with a key Von Duprin – Panic Device (over 50 occupancy – Dogged to meet AB211 Policy) New door – access control card compatible
San Jose City College (2017)	Lever handle on inside and outside <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Single hand operation• Lockable with keys• No other equal Von Duprin – Panic Device (over 50 occupancy) Access control where applicable
Santa Clarita CCD – College of the Canyons (2011)	Lever handle on inside and outside – <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Single hand operation• Lockable from the outside Von Duprin – Panic Device (over 50 occupancy) New doors – access control card compatible
Kern CCD / Bakersfield College (2013)	Lever handle on inside and outside <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Single hand operation• Unclear if it locks from inside or outside, however they use Schlage Von Duprin – Panic Device (over 50 occupancy) New doors – access control card compatible
Los Angeles CCD (date unknown)	Lever handle on inside and outside – lockable from inside <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Single hand operation• Shall be able to be opened from the outside with a key New doors – access control card compatible
San Diego CCD (2011)	Lever handle on inside and outside <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Single hand operation• Does not indicate if lockable from inside (use Best Series Mortise Locks)• Key to get in Von Duprin- Panic Device (over 50 occupancy) New doors – access control card compatible
