## Campus Safety Special Taskforce

**Charge:** Provide Recommendations for campus safety & security plan for the district to provide safety to students and staff and to secure the district facilities for fiscal year 2021-22. Recommendations will go to DEC, then Chancellor's Cabinet and the Board.

- **Data Analysis:**
  - Analyze the crime report and call logs to see what the nature of the crimes/calls for the last 3 to 5 years.
  - Identify the district needs based on the data to provide safety to students and staff and to secure the district facilities.
- **Models:**
  - Look at other institutions safety and security plans
  - Institutions with multi colleges and same size as our district
- **Best Practice:**
  - Is there research on best practice?
- **Open Forums:**
  - Offer open forums at both colleges for students and staff to get input on campus safety and security

**Considerations:**

- a. Armed/sworn personnel
- b. Unarmed resource officers
- c. Overnight security company
- d. CAPS coverage 24 hours
- e. Critical hours for armed personnel coverage
- f. At this time, the district will not consider creating an internal police force.
- g. Once we identify a model and/or models, then a cost analysis will be done.
- h. The taskforce will include AFT, AA, & CSEA representatives. Also, will include mental health services expertise.
