1.	Welcome		
2.	IT Updates	AVC Tarman distributed an updated diagram of the simplified approval process. SOW's take time for discovery and to do the work. The request was made to revis with College only projects shown as the exception.	
		It was mentioned that the new Chancellor is taking the current project list and having conversations about priorities on current projects. IT is currently working on a list for Cabinet to review.	
		Student Planning: A decision regarding curriculum tracks has been made and configuration can move forward. Training materials will be developed for both students and faculty. Ideally, we will have pilot counselors using prior to fall registration in June.	
		AB1504: Student fees increased by \$1 and students have to be able to opt-out. IT is looking into options within Colleague for this functionality. The question was raised about incorporating all different opt-outs into a single place if the functionality exists.	
		Recruit Phase II: IT has been working on how to map CCCApply data through Recruit while also folding in the capability of downloading application data more frequently.	
		SB38 Race-Ethnicity: This is a significant change to information being collected and will be taken care of as part of Recruit Phase II.	
		Registration: There has been a recent request to look at how it would be easier for students to use system. The current focus is on four items: augment search options, sensitive help – if possible, email communication and AB1504.
